*** JOB DESCRIPTION***

Specific duties and responsibilities include, but are not limited to the following:

Clinical Case Manager (RN) position is located in the Behavioral Health Outlying Clinics (BHOC) in the Fort Belvoir Community Hospital, Fort Belvoir, Virginia. The BHOC service provides routine outpatient services. The Clinical Case Manager will be responsible for assisting with call-in and walk-in patient requests to include loading consults into AHLTA, as well as, assisting them with consults placed.

Assist clinic with ensuring access to care is met for all patients to include regular consulted patient and inpatient transfer to outpatient requests. Review consults based on the BH consult review policies of the hospital and TRICARE insurance. Maintain chart reviews for all providers. Assist joint commission key person with unit checks, continuous staff education and training sessions. Assist providers in and out of the facility with questions regarding services/referrals. Assist patients who present in crisis needing to be seen by a provider.

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Screen charts of individuals who are checking in and out of the command. “It is imperative that this screening is conducted by someone with a medical background.” Provide case management of complicated and/or high risk patients while maintaining the high risk log. Coordinate patient list for multidisciplinary meetings. Assist with transfer patient when ER admissions are required. Act as a nurse liaison between primary care, internal medicine and behavioral health thus reducing the number of consults coming directly from PCM and familiar with JC requirements and standards. Overall goal of this PH Officer is to reduce the leakage of care out to civilian care, reduce the no show number and reduce the unfilled appointment numbers to meet FY18 goals.

CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT:

Must be a Registered Nurse and maintain currency.

Must have a background in mental health or social sciences.

Prefer some experience in assessment and recognition of mental health illnesses.

Must be licensed by a State, the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, or territory of the United States.
